



**Chetwyn Che Hin Chan**

**Professor Chetwyn CHAN** is Vice President (Research and Development) and Peter T. C. Lee Chair Professor of Psychology at The Education University of Hong Kong. Professor Chan's research work focuses on exploring mechanisms underlying human learning, particularly perceptual and cross-modal learning employing brain imaging, electroencephalograms, and behavioural methods. He also applies the mechanisms to understand the cognition and behaviours of people with disabilities and older individuals, and design clinical interventions and technologies to enhance the learning and functional capabilities of these individuals. He has published more than 250 research papers and secured more than \$50 million in competitive research and development grants.

Professor Chan has been an Elected Fellow of the American Psychological Association since 2008 and a Fellow of the Hong Kong Psychological Society since 2007. In 2019, Professor Chan and his research team won the Second Class State Scientific and Technology Progress Award from the State Council of the People's Republic of China. In 2025, Professor Chan has received the Second-class Award of the 9th Round Higher Education Outstanding Scientific Research Output Awards (Humanities and Social Sciences) from the Ministry of Education (MoE) of the People's Republic of China and the Second-class Award of Science and Technology Progress Award from Fujian Province.
